AN ABSTRACT EXAMPLE FOR THE SUBMISSION TO EC13

Abstract should be written in clear English and not exceed one A4 page. Please leave top/bottom/right/left margins of 25 mm. Times New Roman (Windows), Times (Macintosh), or other equivalent font set should be used. The following format is recommended: abstract begin with the title (12pt boldfaced), 12pt space, authors' names (11pt italic, the presenting author should be underlined), 6pt space, affiliation(s) and mailing address(es) (9pt), 6pt space, e-mail address of the corresponding author (9pt), all centered, 12pt space, the main text. The main text should be typed with 11pt font size, 0.6 cm first indent, and be fully justified and single-spaced. Abstracts may include a limited number of figures and mathematical formulas as well. Colored figures are generally not accepted (in emergency they will be published as gray-scaled in the Book of Abstracts). An example of a reference citation one can see here [1].

The abstracts have to be send by e-mail as an attached file (preferred), fax or regular mail to Alexander Shalashov before **December 31, 2003**. Filled in pre-registration form should be sent together with an abstract. MS Word, LaTeX, Portable Document Format (pdf) and PostScript file formats are accepted in case of e-mail submission. In order to simplify the publishing procedure Organizing Committee would recommend to send both source file (MS Word or LaTeX) and the result of its conversion into pdf format. After the abstract submission, a confirmation e-mail letter from the EC13 Local Organizing Committee will be sent to the autor. Please contact the Local Organizing Committee in case of not receiving of the confirmation letter within three days after the submission. Note that the confirmation e-mail will be sent only to the corresponding author, and not to the other co-authors. The corresponding authors will be informed of the acceptance of their presentation before **January 31, 2004** by e-mail.
